



## Poster Guidelines

The POSTER protocol for the conference will be as follows:

- POSTERS will be displayed during the Conference, with a drinks session on the evening of Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> November 17:30 – 19:00 providing authors with time to discuss and describe their work.
- Abstracts of poster content will be required and included in the conference program and abstracts distributed to all delegates.
- All posters will be mounted for the whole 5 days of the Conference.
- You'll be encouraged to also be close to your poster during morning and afternoon tea breaks, to enable anyone who wishes to discuss your particular poster topic, to find you and do so!
- You'll thus have several hours of opportunity / exposure during the conference, and we believe that this will give you the widest audience.

To assist you in preparing your poster, we will provide a Velcro-receptive panel on which to mount your poster, whose dimensions should be (max) 1.5m wide x 1.2m high. Posters should be mounted by the presenter, on the morning of Monday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2007. A directory to posters will be included in the Conference Handbook. Secretariat staff will help you find your space and assist you with mounting your poster, please bring your own Velcro spots or pins.

Please ensure that posters are collected by the end of the Conference, as those not collected will be discarded.
