EVENT ORGANISERS PARKING INFORMATION

City of Perth Parking through the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre provides event organisers with the opportunity to purchase a range of pre-paid parking tickets for use at the Convention Centre car park.

Two ticket types are offered as follows:

Bump In / Bump Out / Exhibitor

This option provides 24 hour multiple entry and exit. Fees per ticket commence at \$16.50.

Event Parking

This option provides single entry and exit, 10 hours continuous parking.

Fees per ticket are as follows:

- \$12.00 Entry between 7.30am and 6.00pm
 Monday to Friday
- \$11.00 Entry between 6.00pm and 7.30am
 Monday to Friday
- \$11.00 Entry any time
 Saturday and Sunday
- \$3.50 Hourly Rate (applied pro-rata basis)

Parking tickets are valid from 30 minutes prior to the notified event start time for a duration of 10 continuous hours. Please refer to the CPP handout "How To Use Your Parking Ticket" for operational instructions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

Parking tickets:

- a) are non-refundable once issued;
- b) are only valid for the date and time specified on the application. The patron is fully liable for charges incurred for parking outside the specified time periods;
- c) can only be used at the Convention Centre car park; and
- d) must be used to enter the car park, otherwise standard parking fees will apply.

One parking ticket is issued per car park patron. Any patron using a parking ticket for the purpose of allowing other patrons to enter or exit the facility will have the parking ticket immediately cancelled. Parking ticket monies will not be refunded and the patron will be liable for payment of any standard parking fees due.

The provision of the Parking Local Law 1999 prohibits the parking of vehicles in the following areas: ACROD Bays, Authorised Bays, No Parking Zones, No Standing Zones and Loading Zones.

Vehicles are parked at the owners risk and responsibility. The City of Perth takes no responsibility and is not liable for any loss, damage or injury to any person, vehicle or property of any person within the car park.

Please keep tickets away from magnetic sources as this may cause delays on entry to the car park.

On convention days motorists may experience delays on entering/exiting the car park due to the large volume of traffic.
